ATRIUM

- 90 tons of plant debris removed from property is processed into mulch and compost
- Tower gardens used to grow herbs and vegetables for use in kitchens
- Glass coated and double-paned to reduce solar load on HVAC system
- Used planter pots are donated

- Straws Provided upon request Only
- 23 tons of Commissary kitchen waste collected for mulch and compost
- 110 tons of kitchen oil is filtered, reused, then repurposed for alternate uses
- 384 pounds of honey harvested from hotel's bee colony

GUEST ROOMS

- Compact fluorescent bulbs and LEDs
- Low-flow faucets and toilets
- Water-saver shower heads
- Towel reuse program for housekeeping service

SOUNDWAVES

- Project located on previously developed site; no development of greenfield or undeveloped land
- Custom sloping roof for HVAC efficiency
- HVLV (high volume, low velocity) fans help reduce load on HVAC system
- Use of efficient pool filter systems and variable flow pumps to decrease water and energy consumption
